

ANNUAL ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT 1987-88.

The Election Department, Manipur a non-plan Department is responsible for the successful conduct of all elections to the Legislative Assembly and Lok Sabha in this State under the superintendance, direction and control of the Election Commission of India.

During the year 1987 this Election Department, Manipur as directed by the Election Commission of India undertook a programme for summary revision of Electoral Rolls with 1-1-1987 as the qualifying date as per following programme: -

- (a) Draft publication of rolls: 9-2-1987 (Monday)
- (b) Last date for filing claims and objections: 25-2-87 (Wednesday)
- (c) Final publication after the printing of supplements: 20-3-1987 (Friday)

The District-wise voters after final publication of Electoral Rolls on 20-3-1987 are as follows:-

2. Intensive Revision of Electoral Rolls with 1-1-1988 as the qualifying date.

Further, as directed by the Election Commission of India, for intensive revision of electoral rolls with 1-1-88 as the qualifying date preliminary works relating to preparation of house numbering in rural and urban areas, polling station-wise maps, appointment of enumerators and supervisors and imparting adequate training to them, printing of electoral cards and other connected forms was completed by 31st December, 1987. All these forms, electoral cards, stationery/non-stationery items etc., were supplied to all Deputy Commissioners/Sub-Divisional Officers who are Electoral Regis-

tration Officers. The following are the programme for the above Intensive Revision of Electoral Rolls, 1988:

- 1) House -to - house enumeration : 1-1-1988 to 1-2-1988.
- 2) Preparation of manuscript and printing of draft rolls: by 30-4-1988.
- 3) Draft publication of electoral rolls: 2-5-1988(Monday)
- 4) Period of filing claims and objections: 2-5-1988(Monday) to 1-6-1988(Wednesday).
- 5) Disposal of claims and objections: By 30-6-1988.
- 6) Preparation and printing of supplements: by 30-7-1988(Saturday)
- 7) Final publication of Electoral Rolls: On 1-8-1988.

This office is vigorously processing to identify the Presses for printing of electoral rolls for draft electoral rolls and also for procurement of 12 MTs of white wove paper and 6 MTs of cream wove paper from M/S Hindustan Paper Corporation Ltd., Calcutta as directed by the Election Commission of India and out of 18 MTs papers, 12 MTs of white wove paper is taken delivery on 6-1-88 through ABC, Imphal.

As per programme for Intensive Revision of Electoral Rolls, 1988 this office printed and distributed the following items of enumeration books, general instructions to the Enumerators, stationery, and non-stationery items etc., to all the Electoral Registration Officers.

- 1) Enumeration Books (Manipuri) - 7,700
- 2) Enumeration Books (English) - 5,300
- 3) General Instruction to Enumerators (English & Manipuri) - 2,000
- 4) Letter of Request in Form-4(English)- 5,000
- 5) Certificate with Appendix for Enumerators: - 2,000
- 6) Identity Cards for Enumerators/ Supervisors: - 3,000
- 7) Forms for appointment of Enumerators - 3,500
- 8) Forms for appointment of Supervisors - 1,500

In connection with the Intensive Revision of Electoral Rolls, the following Enumerators and Supervisors were appointed District-wise/Sub-Division-wise for one month during the period 1-1-88 to 1-2-88.

During the year, 1987, this Election Department, Manipur has purchased an Ambassador Car and registered as MNG-2333 at the cost of Rs.1,00,000/- (Approximately).

For procurement of 12 MTs of cream wove/white wove paper and 6 MTs of cream wove paper for printing of electoral rolls and ballot papers a sum of Rs.2,01,240/- (Rupees two lakhs one thousand two hundred forty) only was sanctioned by the Govt. and a sum of Rs.1,81,116/- (Rupees one lakh eighty-one thousand one hundred sixteen) only which is 90% of Rs.2,01,240/- has been paid to M/S Hindustan Paper Corporation Ltd., Calcutta as per terms and conditions of the said Firm.

Budget:

Against a budget provision of Rs.33,84,000/- a sum of Rs.33,62,600/- will be spent during 1987-88.
