

Achievements of Election Department, Manipur
under the Ministry of Law, Government of Manipur.

...

During the ^{reign} of the present Government the following achievements may be enumerated in the Election Department, Manipur.

(I) Countermanded polls in No. 9-Thangmeiband and 44-Ukhrul (ST) Assembly Constituencies were successfully held on 17.5.90.

The death of Smt. M. Punayabati Devi on 2.2.90 a contesting candidate from 9-Thangmeiband Assembly Constituency and Shri Longshim Shaiza on 27.1.90 a contesting candidate from 44-Ukhrul (ST) Assembly Constituency necessitated the countermanded polls to be held on 17.5.1990.

In the countermanded poll in 9-Thangmeiband Assembly Constituency 3 (three) candidates viz., (1) Koijam Radhabinod, INC, (2) Gurumayum Nimaichand Sharma, Janata Dal and (3) Ngangbam Kumarjit, MPP contested the election.

The counting of votes was held on 18.5.90, Koijam Radhabinod, INC secured 6,476 votes, Gurumayum Nimaichand, Janata Dal secured 201 votes and Ngangbam Kumarjit, MPP secured 9,885 votes. Shri Ngangbam Kumarjit, MPP declared elected in the countermand poll in 9-Thangmeiband Assembly Constituency.

In the countermanded poll in 44-Ukhrul (ST) Assembly Constituency 4 (four) candidates viz., (1) A.S. Arthur, INC, (2) Hangmi Shaiza, Janata Dal, (3) Kongsui Luithui, MPP and (4) V. Weapon Zimik, MHPC contested the election.

The counting of votes was held on 21.5.90 A.S. Arthur, INC secured 6828 votes, Hangmi Shaiza, Janata Dal secured 7922 votes, Kongsui Luithui, MPP secured 2988 votes and V. Weapon Zimik, MHPC secured 120 votes.

Hangmi Shaiza, Janata Dal was declared elected in the countermanded poll in 44-Ukhrul (ST) Assembly Constituency.

(II) Summary Revision of electoral rolls with reference to 1.1.1991 as the qualifying date.

The Summary Revision of electoral rolls of all the Assembly Constituencies in the State is now carrying on under the following approved programme of the Election Commission of India :-



The electoral rolls of all the Assembly Constituencies in the State have been published in draft by all the concerned Electoral Registration Officers in the State on 17.12.1990. Claims for inclusion of names and objections to the inclusion of names can be submitted by the public in the prescribed forms 6,7,8 etc. available in the offices of concerned Electoral Registration Officers either in their offices or to the offices authorised by the Electoral Registration Officers or sent by post to the concerned offices on or before 16.1.1991.

(A) (III) Administrative Achievements:- During the period of the present Government 2(two) posts of Supervisors have been filled up by conducting Open Competitive Examination on 21.10.90 and in view of the successful candidates by a D.P.C. on 16.11.90. Further one post of Head Clerk and another post of Supervisor were also filled up on promotion; 9 officers/officials are also declared confirmed against 9 available posts.

(B) Hiring charges of 588 nos. of private vehicles engaged during the last Assembly Election 1990 amounting to Rs.26,87,456/- were also paid out to the vehicle owners.

(C) 400 nos. of tree saplings were also planted in and around the office campus of Election Department, Lamphelpat on 12.8.90 under the guidance of Shri Jarnail Singh, Commissioner (Power & Planning) cum- Chief Electoral Officer, Manipur.
