No. 5/ELEC/SSR-2022: As per the schedule fixed by the Election Commission of India, the Draft Photo Electoral Rolls of all 60 (sixty) Assembly Constituencies have been published today, the **1**st **November**, **2021** by the concerned Electoral Registration Officers (EROs).

- 2. The General Public/Electors and representatives of Political Parties may inspect/verify the Draft Photo Electoral Rolls at the offices of the Electoral Registration Officers/Assistant Electoral Registration Officers and with all the Booth Level Officers (BLOs) and they may also visit Chief Electoral Officer, Manipur's website https://ceomanipur.nic.in to inspect the Draft Photo Electoral Rolls.
- 3. Further, 1(one) printed copy of the Draft Electoral Rolls of each Assembly Constituency and another copy in DVD-ROM will be made available free of cost to the recognised National and State Political Parties. The recognised National/State political parties may depute one representative of their party, duly authorised (in writing), to the CEO's office for this purpose. Any additional copy can be purchased @ Rs.2/- per page and @ Rs.1/- per half page or part thereof. Interested parties may also purchase it from CEO's Office, Lamphelpat @ Rs. 100/-per DVD-ROM per Assembly Constituency.

- 7. A meeting with all recognised national & state political parties was held on 30th October, 2021 wherein they have been briefed about the schedule of Special Summary Revision, 2022. Cooperation was sought from all political parties to make efforts in enrolling all eligible citizens and to take adequate steps for free and fair election.
- 8. First Level Checking of EVMs has started in all the 11 Electoral districts. 44 Engineers from Electronics Corporation of India Ltd are currently deployed. FLC of EVMs in respect of Jiribam district has been completed.
- 9. A team from ECI led by Shri Nitesh Vyas, Deputy Election Commissioner visited the State on 27th October, 2021 to see the preparedness of conduct of elections. Besides, interacting with the Returning Officers & State Nodal Officers, he also held meeting with Chief Secretary and Director General of Police and discussed on various issues including security aspects. The Team also visited Churachandpur, Bishnupur and Imphal West districts.
- 10. With the sole objective of giving maximum awareness to the electors, an "I AM READY" Campaign under Systematic Voters Education and Electoral Participation has been launched

from 3rd September, 2021. In order to create more awareness, 11 State Icons from diverse fields have been identified at the State level and have started engaging them for various activities.
