#### **AUDITOR'S REPORT**

We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of **PEOPLE'S DEMOCRATIC ALLIANCE**, **RAIGAILONG**, **IMPHAL EAST DISTRICT**, **MANIPUR** as at **31.3.2025** and also the attached Income and Expenditure Account and Receipts and Payments Account for the year ended on that date.

#### Organisation's Responsibility for Financial Statements:

On this basis revenue and related assets are recognised when actually received rather than when earned and expenses are recognised when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred.
- 7. Under the scope of audit we have not verified the physical implementation of the programme activities at field level and hence we are unable to comment on the same.
- 8. Instances of cash payments have been observed which should be avoided as far as practicable in future. The practice of cash payments should be gradually discarded.
- 9. In our opinion and to the best of our information and belief and according to information and explanation given to us the said financial statements prepared on the basis of above method of accounting are in agreement with the books of Accounts & Records produced before us and reflect:
  - i) In the case of the Balance sheet the Assets and Liabilities arising from the cash transactions of the above named organisation as at 31.3.2025.
  - ii) In the case of Income and Expenditure Account the excess of income over expenditure of the above named organisation on the basis of the receipts and payments for the year ending on 31.3.2025.
